Current Clients (Employers)

The Kansas Recruitment and Retention Center is currently working with 94 hospitals, community health centers, and physician practices throughout Kansas that are recruiting for one or more health care providers. Among these clients are 39 Critical Access Hospitals, 16 Hospitals (non-CAH), 25 Community Health Centers/Safety Net Clinics, and 14 Group or Private Practices.

Currently, there are 210 job opportunities listed with the Kansas Recruitment and Retention Center.

Placements

The Kansas Recruitment and Retention Center (KRRC) has placed 128 health care providers since inception.

The placements by specialty breakdown is as follows:

- 52 Family (Medicine) Physicians
- 21 Internal Medicine Physicians
- 13 Physician Assistants
- 11 Nurse Practitioners
- 7 Registered Nurses
- 4 Pediatricians
- 3 Radiological Technicians
- 2 General Surgeons
- 2 Hospitalists
- 2 Radiologists
- 2 Dental Hygienists
- 1 Orthopedic Surgeon
- 1 OB/GYN Physician
- 1 Dentist
- 1 Medicine-Pediatrics Physician
- 1 Hematologist/Oncologist
- 1 General Practitioner
- 1 Pulmonologist
- 1 Emergency Medicine Physician
- 1 Ultrasound Technologist



Placement Information Continued

The Kansas Recruitment and Retention Center (KRRC) placed the 128 health care providers in a variety of settings. The facility-type breakdown is as follows:

- 40 placements in a hospital setting (non-CAH)
- 39 placements in a critical access hospital
- 29 placements in a community health center/safety net clinic (KAMU member)
- 20 placements in a group or private practice

Academic Background of Placed Candidates:

- 45 of the physicians placed attended medical school in Kansas (KU School of Medicine)
- 37 of the physicians placed completed residency training in Kansas (KC, Wichita, or Salina)
- 29 of the physicians placed attended medical school and completed residency training in Kansas
- 24 of the non-physician placements completed a health care program in Kansas
